| Question 1. | It was observed this year during the months of June, July, and August that the demand for MGNREGA <br> work in villages went up substantially compared to the same time last year. What do you think were the <br> likely reasons for this increase? How would you go about designing a study to test your hypothesis? |
| Question 2. | Over the years, there have been many calls to replace the in-kind distribution of grains via the Public <br> Distribution System with a cash transfer programme. Do you think this step should be taken? Justify your <br> answer either way. In addition, outline a study that can help you answer the question, which works better, <br> cash or in-kind transfers. |

Notes: MGNREGA stands for Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee act and is a scheme under which rural households are ensured/guaranteed 100 days of work in a year at mandated minimum wages.

PDS stands for Public Distribution System and refers to food purchases (mainly, rice and wheat) from ration shops at subsidised rates.
